Arts and Education Stream Fact sheet for Artists in Residence Projects

You can now apply for artists in residence projects through the new Arts and Education Stream of the Playing Queensland Fund.

Who can apply?

- Schools and kindergartens in regional areas
- Individual artists, arts organisations, and producers
- Performing arts venues, and community presenters
- Museums, galleries, libraries, heritage sites, visitors centres etc.

Where can artists in residence projects happen?

Anywhere in Queensland! The only restriction is that projects must benefit schools and/or kindergartens outside of the Brisbane City Council area.

What type of projects are eligible?

Projects using any art form are eligible as long as the content and/or outcomes are linked to the [Australian Curriculum](#) or the [Early Years Learning Framework](#). Artist in residence projects can take place either as a standalone project or as part of community engagement for a regional tour.

When can I apply?

You can apply any time of the year, as long as it's at least 12 weeks before the start of your planned activity. However, we recommend that you apply with a longer lead time.

How much can I apply for?

You can apply for up to \$20,000 for an artists in residence project. Arts Queensland does not fund 100% of projects so you will need to show other income (cash or in-kind).
